THEME

A Bouquet for an NHS Worker

ELIGIBILITY

One member 16 years of age or under on the 1st of September 2023.

TASK

Prepare an exhibit to depict the theme of 'A bouquet for an NHS worker' using a selection of flowers and natural plant material.

COSTINGS

Not to exceed £30 (excluding Foliage). Costings as well as original receipts to be displayed.

DISPLAY

Competitors are allowed to use back boards but are to supply these themselves.

WORKSPACE

Half a trestle table - working space.

Display space: 76cm wide x 60cm deep x unlimited height.

TIMING

1 hour plus a further 5 minutes to check that arrangements have not been disturbed during cleaning up operations.

PLEASE NOTE: No mobile phones to be used during preparation, competition and setting up

Total 100 - to be judged according to the guideline (outlined below) laid down by the National Association of Flower Arrangement Societies (N.A.F.A.S). - 1. Adherence to the competition wording.
- 2. Predominance of plant material over all other components.
- 3. Plant material that is unblemished, well-conditioned and appropriate.
- 4. Clear interpretation of the title and chosen theme. Plant material should help to interpret the chosen theme without the sole reliance on accessories.
- 5. Good use of design principles and of the space allowed. The use of balance scale, line, space, texture, and colour contribute to the total harmony.
- 6. Tablecloth bases if used, as well as container and any title, in immaculate condition, suitable to the theme and not dominant in size or colour.
- 7. Accessories if used that are in harmony with the rest of the exhibit and that are in scale with it and with each other

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> members are asked to remove all items/displays after 4.30pm (unless announced differently on the day). If not removed within an hour after this time the items will be removed and disposed of.





<u>Please Note:</u> In regards to the Mrs Philippa Gough Trophy for the Overall Achievement Day Trophy, a clubs highest placed points will be accounted for up to the value of 325 points.

Entries to be submitted online by 9^{th} October 2023. NO LATE ENTRY FORMS WILL BE ACCEPTED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.

WITHDRAWAL FROM COMPETITIONS

Clubs/ Members are asked to notify the YFC Office of any withdrawals 5 days prior to a Competition. PLEASE NOTE: All withdrawals from Club secretaries/Members must be made by email or by telephoning the YFC Office. If telephoning out of office hours, then a message should be left on the YFC Mobile phone.

<u>Please Note:</u> That only members with up-to-date membership cards and are on the database in the YFC Office are eligible to compete. Members must apply online at least 5 Days before the competition.

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> If a member does not produce an up-to-date membership card at the competition, it will result in a £5.00 fine. The fine will be refundable only if they provide confirmation of membership within 7 days of the Competition.
