ELIGIBILITY

A club team shall consist of a maximum of five members, who will stage the exhibit on the day of the competition on behalf of the whole club. The five members shall be 28 years of age or under on 1st September 2023.

PROCEDURE

An Exhibit to depict the theme of a Country of your choice. This theme can be interpreted in any way that the club sees fit.

The Club Team is required to exhibit 5 crafts. 1 craft from each of the headings below:

Craft 1

Floral Art

(Any item using cut flowers and accessories in a suitable container- floral foam (Oasis) cannot be used. An alternative eco-friendly option must be used).

Craft 2

Cookery/ Baking

(This craft will be tasted so must be covered with cling film)

Craft 3

Textile Handicraft

(Must include British wool) (Knitwear, Tailored, Crochet for example)

Craft 4

Natural Handicraft

(Any item using wood, metal, clay, glass, stone, or shell for example)

Craft 5

Art

(An item that could include photography, a graphic or a picture in any medium)

The five (5) crafts need to be clearly marked 1-5 together with the heading the craft comes under. For example, 1- Floral Art, 2 - Cookery, 3 - Textile Handicraft, 4- Natural Handicraft, 5 - Art Handicraft.

Each whole Exhibit to have a MAXIMUM WIDTH of 1 metre at any given point and a MAXIMUM DEPTH of 1 metre and MAXIMUM HEIGHT of 1 metre. Any exhibit exceeding the maximum measurements will be disqualified. The measurements will be from the outside edges of the external walls of the exhibit. (i.e., Make your exhibit slightly smaller than the maximum dimensions). Any accessories or drapes used on the outside of the external walls of the cube will be included in the overall measurement of the exhibit. The external walls will be taken into account for the attractiveness of the exhibit marks and so should be covered to compliment the overall exhibit. The exhibit must have 3 walls.

Competitors will be allowed 1 hour to erect their Cube Exhibit.

WITHDRAWAL FROM COMPETITIONS

Clubs/ Members are asked to notify the YFC Office of any withdrawals 5 days prior to a Competition. PLEASE NOTE: All withdrawals from Club secretaries/Members must be made by email or by telephoning the YFC Office. If telephoning out of office hours, then a message should be left on the YFC Mobile phone.

<u>Please Note:</u> That only members with up-to-date membership cards and are on the database in the YFC Office are eligible to compete. Members must apply online at least 5 Days before the competition.

<u>Please Note</u>: If a competitor wishes to compete via zoom, they must inform the office in advance, and each case will be looked at by the County Officials, depending on the Judge, Venue and other circumstances.

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> If a member does not produce an up-to-date membership card at the competition, it will result in a £5.00 fine. The fine will be refundable only if they provide confirmation of membership within 7 days of the Competition.
