Bydd y tîm o dri yn darllen darn a ddewisir ac a ddarperir gan y Beirniad. Bydd angen i gystadleuwyr ddarllen yn llafar, yn Gymraeg ac o flaen cynulleidfa. Caiff bob tîm wybod enw'r llyfr a ddefnyddir (yn cynnwys y rhif ISBN) tair wythnos cyn diwrnod y rownd derfynol. Bydd y Prif Stiward yn rhoi'r detholiadau a ddarllenir i'r cystadleuwyr **ar ddiwrnod y rownd derfynol**. Pennir trefn y cystadlu trwy dynnu enwau o het cyn y gystadleuaeth. Bydd bob tîm yn aros yn yr ystafell baratoi nes daw eu tro hwy i gystadlu i osgoi mantais annheg, oherwydd bydd yr holl dimau yn darllen yr un detholiad. Felly, ni chaniateir i gystadleuwyr na'u hyfforddwy'r fod yn yr ystafell ble cynhelir y gystadleuaeth cyn iddynt hwy gystadlu. Bydd cystadleuwyr yn gallu dewis darllen o lyfr neu o'r cerdyn a ddarperir, neu gan ddefnyddio dyfais electronig megis Kindle a ddarperir gan y cystadleuydd. Bydd y Cadeirydd yn cyflwyno'r tîm ac yn amlinellu cefndir y llyfr yn gryno. Bydd angen i bob aelod o'r tîm (gan gynnwys y Cadeirydd) ddarllen darn gwahanol o'r llyfr, ond bydd bob tîm yn darllen yr un detholiadau â'r timau eraill. Caiff timau 30 munud cyn iddynt gystadlu i ddarllen y detholiadau gyda'u hyfforddwy'r yn yr ystafell baratoi. Cofiwch y bydd bob tîm yn rhannu'r ystafell baratoi.

- Gall aelodau ddarllen y detholiadau a roddir iddynt yn yr ystafell baratoi.
- Caniateir llyfrau yn yr ystafell baratoi ymlaen llawn.
- Caniateir i bob tîm gael un hyfforddwr yn yr ystafell baratoi.

Bydd timau'n cael eu cosbi am ddefnyddio jôcs ffaidd nei iaith anwedus. Atgoffir timau mai Cystadleuaeth Siarad Cyhoeddus yw hon a rhoddir marciau am areithiau - sobir cymeriadau l'r eithaf. Mae barnwyr yn cadw'r hawl i ddiarddel timau/aelodau y maent y neu gweld yn dramgwyddus neu'n wahaniaethol.

ELIGIBILITY

Clubs may enter as many teams as they like. A team shall consist of three members, each of whom must be 14 years of age or under on 1st September 2023.

PROCEDURE

A team of three members to read a passage selected and provided by the Judge. Competitors will be required to read aloud, in Welsh and in front of an audience. The title of the book (including ISBN number) to be used will be notified to each team **three weeks** before the competition.

The passages to be read will be given to finalists by the Chief Steward **on the day**.

A draw will be made for the order of appearance prior to the competition.

All teams will be held in the preparation room until it is their turn to compete to avoid an unfair advantage as all teams are reading the same text. Therefore, competitors and trainers will not be allowed into the room where the competition is taking place before competing.

Competitors have the choice to read from the book or from the card provided or from an electronic device such as a Kindle, supplied by the competitor.

The Chairman to introduce the team and give a brief background about the book.

Each member of the team (including the Chairman) will be required to read a different passage from the book, but each team will read the same set of passages as the other teams.

Teams will be given 30 minutes before they compete to read through the passages with their trainer in the preparation room. Please bear in mind that the preparation room will be shared by all teams.

- Members may read through their given passages in the preparation room.
- Books are allowed in the preparation room beforehand.
- One Trainer per team is allowed in the preparation room.

Teams will be penalised for using distasteful jokes or bad language. Teams are reminded that this is a Public Speaking Competition and marks are awarded for speeches - characters to the extreme will be penalised. Judges reserve the right to disqualify teams/members they perceive to be offensive or discriminatory.

TIMING

Chairman (opening)

2 minutes

Penalties: Time deductions are one mark for each half-minute (or part thereof) over the allocated time. Members reading will not have an allocated time.
