THEME

Emergency Services Celebration Dinner

TEAM

Two members 28 years of age or under on the 1st of September 2023.

TASK

Team of 2 members to cook a two-course meal set by the Judge. Members will be given a list of ingredients and the method/recipe on the day for members to follow. One dish will be savoury and one will be sweet.

All necessary ingredients will be provided with costs not exceeding £20.

EQUIPMENT

A list of equipment needed will be circulated 1 week prior to the competition, including display dishes.

Members to bring salt and pepper.

Teams must bring with them their own 2 gas rings with them.

TIMING

One hour for cooking, including displaying the dishes in the white alcove (68.5cm x 68.5cm x 61cm high) (background material and accessories can be arranged before the hour starts and will not be included in the time).

15 minutes will be given to read and understand the recipe.

1 hour will be allowed to cook the recipe - as well as weigh and prepare the ingredients.

An additional 15 minutes will be allowed for members to complete a food hygiene questionnaire.

TIME PENALTIES

Should teams not finish within the hour for cooking (additional 15 minutes for questionnaire), 1 point per minute will be deducted from the overall score.

WORKSPACE

One trestle table including cooker space.

DISPLAY

Meal to be displayed in the white alcove which competitor must provide (68.5cm x 68.5cm x 61cm high) (backing material and accessories may be arranged by the competitors prior to the commencement of the one hour and will be outside of this time).

All exhibits to be within the alcove size/space including any drapes or lining, in/on serving dishes/containers (competitors to supply).



Accessories that are in harmony with the rest of the exhibit and that are in scale with it and each other, but not dominant, are allowed.

Parents/ Helpers are not allowed to assist members with the display or any preparation on the display. ******

PLEASE NOTE: No mobile phones to be used during preparation, competition and setting up.
