# FLORAL COMPETITION

THEME: On the Farm

#### TEAM

One member 21 years of age or under on 1st September 2021.

#### TASK

Prepare a modern exhibit to depict any aspect of the agrictultural industry using a seclection of flowers and natural plant material.

#### COSTINGS

Not to exceed £30 (excluding Foliage). Costings to be displayed. Credibility of costings will be taken into account by the judge and the judges will be asked to be stricter and adjust marks accordingly.

#### DISPLAY

Competitors are allowed to use back boards but are to supply these themselves.

#### WORK SPACE

Half a trestle table - working space. Display space: 76cm wide x 60cm deep x unlimited height.

#### TIME

1 hour plus a further 5 minutes to check that arrangements have not been disturbed during cleaning up operations.

**Total 100** - to be judged according to the guidelines (outlined below) laid down by the National Association of Flower Arrangement Societies (N.A.F.A.S.). Copies of the NAFAS Competitions Manual (third edition) may be obtained from NAFAS Enterprises Ltd, Osborne House, 12 Devonshire Square, London, EC2M 4TE. Tel: 02072 475567.

- 1. Adherence to the competition wording.
- 2. Predominance of plant material over all other components.
- 3. Plant material that is unblemished, well conditioned and appropriate.
- 4. Clear interpretation of the title and chosen theme. Plant material should help to interpret the chosen theme without the sole reliance on accessories.
- 5. Good use of design principles and of the space allowed. The use of balance, scale, line, space, texture, and colour contribute to the total harmony.
- 6. Tablecloth and bases if used, as well as container and any title, in immaculate condition, suitable to the theme and not dominant in size or colour.
- 7. Accessories if used that are in harmony with the rest of the exhibit and that are in scale with it and with each other

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> Members are asked to remove all items/displays by 4.30pm (unless announced differently on the day). If not collected an hour after this time the items will be removed and disposed of.

Entries to be submitted online by <u>Monday 8<sup>th</sup> November 2021</u>. NO LATE ENTRY FORMS WILL BE ACCEPTED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.

#### WITHDRAWAL FROM COMPETITIONS

Clubs/Members are asked to notify the YFC Office of any withdrawals 5 days prior to a Competition. <u>PLEASE</u> <u>NOTE:</u> <u>All withdrawals from Club Secretaries/Members must be made by email or by telephoning the YFC</u> <u>Office. If telephoning out of office hours then a message should be left on the answer phone.</u>

FOR COMPETITORS/TEAMS WHO DO NOT TURN UP FOR A COMPETITION ON THE DAY, THE COUNTY OFFICIALS WILL MAKE THE DECISION WHETHER TO DEDUCT THE 5 POINTS OR NOT, DEPENDING ON CIRCUMSTANCES.

<u>Please Note:</u> "That only members with up-to-date plastic membership cards and are on the database in the YFC Office are eligible to compete. Any new members forms and photos <u>must</u> be attached to the Entry Form when returned by clubs."

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> If a member does not produce an up-to-date membership card at the competition, it will result in a £5.00 fine. The fine will be refundable only if they provide confirmation of membership within 7 days of the Competition. If they have not yet joined, they will have 7 days to send a form and photograph to the YFC Office.
