AGES IN ALL SECTIONS - **PLEASE NOTE ONLY TWO AGE CATEGORIES**

27 years of age or under on 1st September 2020.

19 years of age or under on 1st September 2020.

ELIGIBILITY

Team of two members (1 x 27 and 1 x 19 years of age or under on the 1 September 2020). This age range must be adhered to, and all competitors must be full members of a Club affiliated to Brecknock.

Competitors will be required to hold a current membership card.

PROCEDURE

Competitors to place in order of merit and give reasons on one line of 4 carcasses.

A film (between five and ten minutes in length) or a set of images of four Carcasses will be shown to the competitors, providing the opportunity to view and make notes.

Following the film or viewing the images or once judging has concluded, competitors must send their placings via messenger to the Brecknock YFC Facebook including their name, club and whether Junior or Senior Competitor. All competitors must have the facility to send over their recording of themselves delivering their reasons to Brecknock YFC.

The recording must be sent via Brecknock YFC Facebook messenger or email (<u>brecknockyfc@gmail.com</u>) within 30 minutes following your viewing images time. If recording is not received within the 30 minutes your entry will not be accounted for.

Competitors will be allowed up to two minutes speaking time for stating their reasons on the carcasses to the judge. Your time will start as soon as the competitor starts speaking and time will end as soon as they finish speaking. Competitors exceeding this time limit will incur penalties at the rate of 2 marks for each 15 seconds or part thereof. The marks to be deducted from their total score.

A video of the top three entries in each section will be created and posted onto social media channels to showcase the competition, as well as providing a basis for future competitors of stock judging competitions.
