- Competitors to report half an hour before the commencement of their respective competition for a Draw to be made.
- Play to commence promptly in each of the competitions.

Once a team signs in to play any sport and play begins, that original team must remain the same throughout the competition. Clubs are allowed one guest per team. Guest must be YFC member from another club within the Federation and not played in another competition on the day/evening. If clubs have more than one guest then the points are split or the combined team play for fun and no points are awarded. For mixed competitions, if teams have too many girls or not enough boys then teams are allowed to play at a disadvantage only

ELIGIBILITY

No restriction on number of entries allowed per club.

Team of two Members 28 years of age or under on 1st September 2021.

PROCEDURE

Rules as per the British Association of pool Table operators will apply.

Order of play determined by flip of a coin.

League type tables will be used whenever possible.

The facilities available will determine whether the competition will be played on a knockout or league basis and on the entries on the night.

a) Knockout - Best of three frames b) League - One straight frame

DARTS - Boys Singles, Girls Singles & Mixed Doubles

ELIGIBILITY

2 entries allowed in each section.

Members to be 28 years of age or under on 1st September 2021.

PROCEDURE

Boys Singles:

Games to consist of 3 legs 501 Flying start Double or Bull to finish Throw for Bull in 1st and 3rd legs

Competitors to supply their own darts.

Points will be awarded for every leg won.

from face of board with also 8' line.

The dart board shall be standard 1 - 20 clock pattern, height to be 5'8" from centre of bull to floor level, and the minimum throwing distance shall be back edge of raised toe hockey 7'6" measured along the floor

The "bust" rule will apply i.e. if you score more than you require you revert back to the score required prior to your opponents' last throw.

Girls Singles:

Flying start

Games to consist of 3 legs 301

Throw for Bull in 1st and 3rd legs

Double or Bull to finish

The bull counts as 50. If 50 is required for game shot the bull does count as double 25.

No dart to be retrieved from dart board until the score has been recorded by scorer/referee. Protest after retrieval of dart may not be accepted.

The score is counted from the side of segment wire and dart pierces.

The decision of the Referee will be final.

Draw to be made on the evening.

Entries to be submitted online by <u>Monday 14th February 2022</u>. NO LATE ENTRY FORMS WILL BE ACCEPTED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.

WITHDRAWAL FROM COMPETITIONS

Clubs/Members are asked to notify the YFC Office of any withdrawals 5 days prior to a Competition. PLEASE NOTE: All withdrawals from Club Secretaries/Members must be made by email or by telephoning the YFC Office. If telephoning out of office hours then a message should be left on the answer phone.

FOR COMPETITORS/TEAMS WHO DO NOT TURN UP FOR A COMPETITION ON THE DAY, THE COUNTY OFFICIALS WILL MAKE THE DECISION WHETHER TO DEDUCT THE 5 POINTS OR NOT, DEPENDING ON CIRCUMSTANCES.

<u>Please Note:</u> "That only members with up-to-date plastic membership cards and are on the database in the YFC Office are eligible to compete. Any new members forms and photos <u>must</u> be attached to the Entry Form when returned by clubs."

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> If a member does not produce an up-to-date membership card at the competition, it will result in a £5.00 fine. The fine will be refundable only if they provide confirmation of membership within 7 days of the Competition. If they have not yet joined, they will have 7 days to send a form and photograph to the YFC Office.
