### **SENIOR MEMBER OF THE YEAR**

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

The competitor shall be 18 years or over and 28 years or under on 1st September 2021.

#### **PROCEDURE**

##### **PART 1**

Two weeks prior to the competition at the Public Speaking Day, competitors will be required to complete and submit to the YFC Office a synopsis form (provided), to be no more than 2 sides of A4, which will show details of their YFC activities.

(Special emphasis should be placed on their involvement at Club level).

##### **PART 2**

Competitors will be interviewed on the day by a Judge(s), in an informal atmosphere.

#### **OBJECTIVES**

The objective of the competition is to select a member who has shown that they are involved in all aspects of the YFC Movement. Judges will be looking for:

- Involvement at club level for period of membership.
- Overall YFC involvement. (i.e. club, county, area or national)
- Specific involvement in activities in the previous 12 months. (conservation, competitions, recruitment, programming, charity, sport, club officer)
- General commitment to YFC - awareness of fellow members' interests in YFC and objective view of the future of the organisation.
- Knowledge of the YFC at Club, County, Area and National levels and to share that knowledge over the 12 month period following the final.

#### **SCALE OF MARKS - Total 100 marks**

**WITHDRAWAL FROM COMPETITIONS**

If telephoning out of office hours then a message should be left on the answer phone.**

**Please Note:** "That only members with up-to-date plastic membership cards and are on the database in the YFC Office are eligible to compete. Any new members forms and photos *must* be attached to the Entry Form when returned by clubs."

**PLEASE NOTE:** If a member does not produce an up-to-date membership card at the competition, it will result in a £5.00 fine. The fine will be refundable only if they provide confirmation of membership within 7 days of the Competition. If they have not yet joined, they will have 7 days to send a form and photograph to the YFC Office.
