- 1. <u>ELIGIBILITY</u>. Each club may enter as many teams as they like. Members to be 28 years of age or under on 1st September 2021 and with Membership Cards in the YFC Office.
- 2. <u>PROCEDURE.</u> A team shall consist of <u>three members</u> a Master of Ceremonies, Guest Speaker (who will propose the main toast), and a Respondent to Guest Speaker.

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> (A Team of 5 will then be selected by the Judge to represent the Federation at the Wales YFC Final).

- 3. Teams will be split so that the MC, Guest Speaker and Respondent to Guest Speaker will operate in different teams. The MC from Team A will work with the Guest Speaker from Team B and the Respondent from Guest Speaker from Team A.
- 4. Teams will be notified 14 days before competing of their toast for the evening. Once the draw is done and topics have been issued, if any team withdraws from the competition they will incur 50 points off their overall winter points.
- 5. Competitors may use notes but may be penalised if these are excessive.
- 6. Teams will be given the opportunity of meeting to exchange notes 20 minutes before appearing on the platform.
- 7. Master of Ceremonies would be a member of the organisation giving the dinner (i) Welcome members (ii) Welcome Guest (iii) Introduce the Guest Speakers
- 8. Guest Speaker would not be a member of the association giving the dinner (i) Speech (ii) Call on Company to drink to Master Ceremonies
- 9. Master of Ceremonies Introduce respondent to reply to roast
- 10. Respondent to Guest Speaker Would normally be a member of the association giving the dinner (i) replies
- 11. Master of Ceremonies Concludes.
