

BRECKNOCK YFC 'YFC TALENT' COMPETITION



Social Media - 2nd - 4th July 2021

(Entries to be submitted by 12non Monday 21st June 2021)

RULES

Clubs are allowed to enter a maximum of two teams in each (Junior or Senior) 'YFC Talent' Competitions.

ELIGIBILITY

Class 1 - Junior

The team will consist of **up to SIX (6)** competitors, all of whom must be 17 years of age or under on 1st September 2020 and a full member of Brecknock YFC.

Class 2 - Senior

The team will consist of **up to SIX (6)** competitors, all of whom must be 27 years of age or under on 1st September 2020 and a full member of Brecknock YFC.

Both sections (Junior and Senior) entries will be judge for the NFYFC final.

PROCEDURE

- Teams are required to record themselves performing a specific talent. This could be Musical, Singing, Instrumental, Dancing or a Comedy Sketch for example. Props are permitted in videos.
- To adhere to Government Guidelines, entries should be from the same household/support bubble. Where entries are not from the same household or bubble, social distancing must be maintained.
- Each performance should begin with an introduction (Names, Club, County) and a brief description of the talent.
- Teams are reminded that material considered to be distasteful or inappropriate may result in the loss of marks. All material to be suitable for a family audience. The use of foul language will be penalised with a deduction of marks.
- Video clips to be sent into Brecknock YFC no later than 12noon Monday 21st June 2021 alongside
 a form documenting membership details of all performers. Please contact the YFC office for
 Google Drive link.

PRS

• Teams to provide a completed PRS form documenting any music used in their performance. PRS forms can be downloaded from the website.

TIMING

- Videos to be no more than THREE (3) minutes in length
- Time faults will be imposed for timings above the time limit, at a rate of 2 marks deducted per 15 seconds or part thereof.
- The introduction for the competing team will not be included in the (3minutes). The time will commence from the first note spoken for the first note played.
- Teams can use the time as they wish but there must be a link in between acts to make an overall performance.

Entries to be submitted to the YFC office by 12noon Monday 21st June 2021. All entries will be published on social media from the 2nd - 4th July. Winner will be announced on the 4th July.

Please note: That only members with up-to-date plastic membership cards and are on the database in the YFC Office are eligible to compete. Any new members forms, and photos MUST be attached to entry.
