ELIGIBILITY

The team may consist of between 6 and 12 members, with at least 2 male and 2 female team members, all of whom must be 28 years of age or under on 1st September 2023.

PROCEDURE

The team should perform one Disco Dancing Routine *.

Size of the dance area to be approximately 10m x 10m.

*Definition: "Freestyle Disco Dancing is the trendiest and most popular form of dance in the UK today. It involves runs, spins, kicks and leaps as well as many other diverse steps and movements with lots of different arm and hand actions. The music can be fast and "beaty" or slow and sensuous, allowing dancers of all ages to use freedom of expression to enhance their style" (taken from the International Dance Teachers Association website www.idta.co.uk - click on Styles).

All music must be a Radio Edit - i.e., suitable and passed for radio broadcast to family audiences.

Please Note: At the request of the PA provider all music must be sent to the office by Friday 27th October 2023

TIMING

A minimum of 3 minutes and a maximum of 5 minutes will be allowed for the routine.

Time penalties - Time deductions are one mark for each 15 seconds (or part thereof) over or under the allocated time by any member of the team.
