### **ELIGIBILITY**

The team may consist of between 6 and 10 members, all of whom must be 28 years of age or under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022. The team must consist of a minimum of 2 members of the opposite gender.

#### PROCEDURE

Each team is required to demonstrate a Street Style Dance (minimum of 3 and maximum of 5 minutes) to the theme 'Around the World'.

Street dancing is a form of dance that showcases body movements through individual style and originality. Street dancing is funky and fun with character and attitude.

It is very dynamic with strong movements, and normally has a story behind it (i.e., gang culture/crews/battles etc.)

All music must be a Radio Edit - i.e., suitable and passed for radio broadcast to family (pre-watershed) audiences.

#### <u>TIMING</u>

A minimum of 3 minutes and a maximum of 5 minutes will be allowed for the routine.

**Time penalties** - Time deductions are one mark for each 15 seconds (or part thereof) over or under the allocated time by any member of the team.
