## THEME

Two Street Food style courses, suitable for serving at the Circus

### **TEAM**

Two members 21 years of age or under on the 1st of September 2022.

#### **TASK**

A team of two members to prepare two street food courses for two people, to be served at the Circus. Local produce to be used where possible.

Competitors will need to include a minimum of one savoury and one sweet dish.

An additional 15 minutes will be allowed for members to complete a food hygiene questionnaire.

Costs must not exceed £20 in total.

#### **EQUIPMENT**

No equipment will be provided but members may provide and use either a Grill and small ring, oven and small ring or two rings only. A 13-amp socket will be available for any appliances that competitors may wish to use, such as a mixer, liquidiser etc.

Only one extra socket will be allowed.

Teams must bring with them an extension lead.

#### **TIMING**

One hour for cooking, to include displaying of meal in own white alcoves (68.5cm x 68.5cm x 61cm high) (backing material and accessories may be arranged prior to the commencement of the one hour and will be outside of this time). No cooking to be done beforehand, but ingredients may be weighed, and vegetables/fruit washed beforehand. Recipes and research work must be presented and displayed.

#### **WORKSPACE**

One trestle table including cooker space.

#### **DISPLAY**

Meal to be displayed in the white alcove which competitor must provide ( $68.5 \text{cm} \times 68.5 \text{cm} \times 61 \text{cm}$  high) (backing material and accessories may be arranged by the competitors prior to the commencement of the one hour and will be outside of this time).

All exhibits to be within the alcove size/space including any drapes or lining, in/on serving dishes/containers (competitors to supply).

Accessories that are in harmony with the rest of the exhibit and that are in scale with it and each other, but not dominant, are allowed.



Members are encouraged not to use alcoholic drinks as part of their display, instead they should look for non-alcoholic alternatives or use empty bottles where possible.
