ELIGIBILITY

One member 16 years of age or under on the 1st of September 2022.

TASK

To create an accessory or item to be used at the circus and produce an A3 mood board showing the design and workmanship of the item. No restrictions on the types of materials used. Costumes are not considered an accessory or item.

On competition day the member will be asked to complete a practical test as instructed by the judge and therefore must bring replica materials with them.

MEASUREMENTS

Half a trestle table - working space for practical test

Display space - Half a trestle table.

COSTINGS

Not to exceed £20 in total

TIMING

45 minutes allowed for the practical test and 15 minutes to display the exhibit.
