Bydd tîm yn cynnwys Cadeirydd, Siaradwr a Chynigydd y Diolchiadau. Caniateir i gystadleuwyr fod yn Ystafell y Gystadleuaeth cyn ac wedi iddynt gystadlu. Bydd y drefn yn dilyn trefn cyfarfod cyffredinol. Cyflwynir y Cadeirydd i'r Siaradwr bymtheg munud cyn bydd tîm y Cadeirydd yn cystadlu.

Bydd y Siaradwr yn darparu nodiadau ysgrifenedig â manylion y pwnc a ddewiswyd a manylion personal (ee. Ysgol, diddordebau arbennig, aelodaeth CFFl, swyddi yn y Clwb, gweithgareddau o fewn y Clwb, ac ati) Dylid ysgrifennu'r nodiadau hyn ar y cerdyn a ddarperir a'u cyflwyno i'r Prif Stiward ar ddechrau'r gystadleuaeth a bydd y nodiadau ar **gael** i'r Cadeirydd a'r beirniad.

Sylwer y gellir defnyddio PowerPoint fel cymhorth gweledol i'r Siaradwr, ond ni ddylid ei ddefnyddio trwy gydol yr araith a gellir eu defnyddio i ychwanegu at yr araith yn unig. H.y. **NID** cystadleuaeth cyflwyniad busnes yw hwn. Bydd y Siaradwr, a fydd yn westai i dîm arall, yn dewis ei bwnc ei hun. Yna bydd y Siaradwr yn ateb cwestiwn o ofynnir gan y Cynigydd ac yna cwestiwn gan y panel beirniad. Ni ofynnir cwestiynau o'r llawr/ cynulleidfa. Y cyfanswm o ddau gwestiwn fydd yn cael eu gofyn. Bydd y cadeirydd yn gwahodd y beirniad i ofyn cwestiwn/ cwestiynau i'r siaradwr, a fydd yn ymateb. Bydd y Cynigydd yn eistedd yn ystafell y gystadleuaeth. Bydd yn codi pwynt penodol o anerchiad y siaradwr ac yn rhoi sylwadau, cytuno neu anghytuno ac yn gofyn un cwestiwn sy'n berthnasol i bwnc yr anerchiad. Bydd yn cynnig diolchiadau i'r Siaradwr ar ôl i'r holl gwestiynau gael eu trafod. Ni chaniateir unrhyw gyfathrebu, yn ysgrifenedig neu ar lafar, rhwng aelodau'r tîm neu'r gynulleidfa, a bydd gwneud hynny yn arwain at eich **diarddel o'r gystadleuaeth yn syth**.

ELIGIBILITY

Clubs can enter as many teams as they like. A team shall consist of three members, each of whom must be 16 years of age or under on 1st September 2022.

PROCEDURE

The team shall consist of a Chairman, Speaker and Proposer of the Vote of Thanks. Competitors before and after competing may be admitted to the competition room. The procedure will follow that of a normal meeting. Fifteen minutes before his or her team is due to compete; the Chairman will be introduced to the speaker.

The Speaker will provide written notes giving the subject chosen and personal background (e.g. school, special interests, YFC membership, Club Offices held, activities within the Club, etc.). These notes to be written on the card provided and handed to the Chief Steward at the beginning of the competition and will be **available** for the Chairmen and Judges.

To note that Power Point may be used as a visual aid for the Speaker but they are not to be used for the whole speech and can only be used to enhance the speech. i.e. this is **NOT** a business presentation competition.

The Speaker, who will be the guest of another team, will choose his/ her own subject. The Speaker will then answer a question put by the Proposer and then a question from the judging panel.

There is to be no questions asked from the floor/audience. A total of two questions will be asked.

The Chairman will invite the judges to put one question to the speaker who will then respond.

The Proposer will be seated in the body of the hall. He/she will take up some point in the Speaker's address, comment, agree, or disagree and ask one pertinent question on the subject matter of address. He/she will give the Vote of Thanks to the Speaker after all questions have been dealt with.

No communication, written or verbal between any of the team members, or the audience, will be
