16 years of age or under on 1st September 2023

TIMING IN ALL SECTIONS

<u>Judging</u> - 10 minutes allowed

<u>Preparing Reasons</u> - 5 minutes allowed

<u>Reasons</u> - 2 minutes for stating reasons. Competitors exceeding this time limit will incur

penalties at the rate of 2 marks for each 15 seconds or part thereof. The marks to

be deducted from their total score.

<u>Please Note:</u> All reasons must be written on Dunbia stockjudging cards which will be provided on the day. No prewritten notes to be used.

The results gained by each competitor will be recorded and:

- THE EVAN MORGAN SHIELD will be presented to the member gaining the most points 28 years of age or under.
- THE SENNYBRIDGE YFC TROPHY will be awarded to the member gaining the most points 21 years of age or under





• THE SPECIAL AWARD will be awarded to the member gaining the most points 18 years of age or under



- THE ROBERT DAVIES TROPHY will be awarded to the member gaining the most points 16 years of age or under
- THE FUW TROPHY will be awarded for the individual gaining the highest score from the Stockjudging,
 Animal Health and Carcass Judging Competitions 28 & 21 years of age or under
- THE CALEB ROBERTS TROPHY will be awarded to the individual gaining the highest score from the Stockjudging, Animal Health and Carcass Judging Competitions 18 & 16 years of age or under

Stockjudging & Carcass Judging Competitions will be Eliminators for the following events. Please note that members will only be considered for selection in the section/age category they competed in at the County Competition:

• English Winter Fair - 18th & 19th November 2023

Competitors in each age group; 28, 21 and under will be chosen on Stockjudging ability and Carcass Judging

Royal Welsh Winter Fair - 27th & 28th November 2023

Competitors in each age group; 28, 21, 18 and 16 years will be chosen on Stockjudging ability and Carcass Judging

Wales YFC Senior Stockman of the Year & Young Stockman of the Year - 27th April 2024

For the All-Wales YFC Senior Stockman of the Year & Young Stockman of the Year Competitions which are held at the Field Day next April; the Stockjudging marks will be amalgamated with the Animal Health Competition marks for the respective age groups, and competitors chosen accordingly.

Entries to be submitted online by $\underline{25^{th}}$ September 2023. NO LATE ENTRY FORMS WILL BE ACCEPTED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.

WITHDRAWAL FROM COMPETITIONS

Clubs/ Members are asked to notify the YFC Office of any withdrawals 5 days prior to a Competition. PLEASE NOTE: All withdrawals from Club secretaries/Members must be made by email or by telephoning the YFC Office. If telephoning out of office hours then a message should be left on the YFC Mobile phone.

<u>Please Note:</u> That only members with up-to-date membership cards and are on the database in the YFC Office are eligible to compete. Members must apply online at least 5 Days before the competition.

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> If a member does not produce an up-to-date membership card at the competition, it will result in a £5.00 fine. The fine will be refundable only if they provide confirmation of membership within 7 days of the Competition.
