ELIGIBILTY

The Competitor must be 17 years of age or under on 1st of September 2022.

PROCEDURE

Part 1 - Synopsis Form

Two weeks prior to the competition, competitors will be required to complete and submit to the YFC Office a synopsis form (provided), to be no more than 2 sides of A4, which will show details of their YFC activities.

(Special emphasis should be placed on their involvement at Club Level)

Synopsis forms to be with the YFC Office by 4pm on the 13th February 2023.

Part 2 - Presentation & Formal Interview

Competitors will be required to prepare a presentation using Microsoft Power Point software to include their experiences gained at YFC Club, County, Area and National. They should also include activities outside of YFC.

Presentation should be based on experiences gained in the 12 months before the competition final. The presentation is to compliment your Synopsis Form.

Timing - it should be no less than 3 and no more than 10 minutes long.

The presentation will be made to the judges only, on completion of the presentation the judges will ask questions on the Synopsis form, on the competitor's knowledge of YFC and/or current issues or news relating to young people.

SCALE OF MARKS -Total 100 marks

Penalties: Time deductions are one mark for each half-minute (or part thereof) over or under the allocated time of the presentation. The judges may also deduct marks if the timings are below half of what is expected.

Notes: Competitors are reminded to dress appropriately for the competition (smart clothing suitable for an interview scenario)

The Judge's decision will be final.

WITHDRAWAL FROM COMPETITIONS

Clubs/ Members are asked to notify the YFC Office of any withdrawals 5 days prior to a Competition. PLEASE NOTE: All withdrawals from Club secretaries/Members must be made by email or by telephoning the YFC Office. If telephoning out of office hours, then a message should be left on the YFC Mobile phone.

<u>Please Note:</u> That only members with up-to-date membership cards and are on the database in the YFC Office are eligible to compete. Members must apply online at least 5 Days before the competition.

<u>Please Note</u>: If a competitor wishes to compete via zoom, they must inform the office in advance, and each case will be looked at by the County Officials, depending on the Judge, Venue and other circumstances.

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> If a member does not produce an up-to-date membership card at the competition, it will result in a £5.00 fine. The fine will be refundable only if they provide confirmation of membership within 7 days of the Competition.

General Rules apply to all competitions alongside the competition's rules.
