## **CLUB DISPLAY**

### **THEME:**

Book Club - 'My Favourite Book'

**PLEASE NOTE:** Nursery Rhymes and Fairytales are not considered suitable as stories or the basis for any of the competitions under the theme Book Club.

### **TEAM**

Up to six members (26 years of age or under on 1st September 2019). No more than four members to stage and prepare displays. The two additional members are only permitted to erect the frame. Judges will be invited to ask questions regarding workmanship of items.

### **MEASUREMENTS**

Space allowed 6' (1m 82.9 cm) high; 6' (1m 82.9 cm) wide; 4'6" (1m 37.1 cm) deep - maximum outside measurements. Displays which do not meet the necessary size specifications will be penalised.

### **TIME**

Teams will have two hours from 10am - 12noon to set up displays. Any late arrivals will not be given extra time.

### **ELECTRIC**

One electric socket will be available per display, and only one trailing lead allowed from the display. It is a requirement that any plugs being used by competitors are PAT tested.

### **NOTES**

All members must wear white coats. Participating Clubs to be responsible for all labelling, this may be in English only, Welsh only, or bilingual. All construction to be made by members. All competitors to leave everything on display until 4.30pm (unless announced differently on the day) and therefore no perishable foods allowed. Competitors are responsible for all items on display.

Teams must remember that the exhibit should be suitable for viewing by all ages.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Members are asked to remove all items/displays by 4.30pm (unless announced differently on the day). If not collected an hour after this time the items will be removed and disposed of.

### WITHDRAWAL FROM COMPETITIONS

Clubs/Members are asked to notify the YFC Office of any withdrawals 5 days prior to a Competition. PLEASE NOTE: All withdrawals from Club Secretaries/Members must be made by email or by telephoning the YFC Office. If telephoning out of office hours then a message should be left on the answer phone.

FOR COMPETITORS/TEAMS WHO DO NOT TURN UP FOR A COMPETITION ON THE DAY, THE COUNTY OFFICIALS WILL MAKE THE DECISION WHETHER TO DEDUCT THE 5 POINTS OR NOT, DEPENDING ON CIRCUMSTANCES.

Please Note: "That only members with up-to-date plastic membership cards and are on the database in the YFC Office are eligible to compete. Any new members forms and photos must be attached to the Entry Form when returned by clubs."

PLEASE NOTE: If a member does not produce an up-to-date membership card at the competition, it will result in a £5.00 fine. The fine will be refundable only if they provide confirmation of membership within 7 days of the Competition. If they have not yet joined, they will have 7 days to send a form and photograph to the YFC Office.
