# JUNIOR FENCING

#### ELIGIBILITY

A team shall consist of three members, two members shall be 21 years of age or under on the 1<sup>st</sup> September 2019 and one member shall be 18 years of age or under on the 1<sup>st</sup> September 2019.

#### PROCEDURE

Teams are to erect 12 metres of stock netting with barb wire top and bottom and a join in only the netting. The join can be located in a section of netting of their choice.

Only materials supplied by the organisers are to be used for the Brecknock YFC Final (see list of materials below).

Hand tools only will be allowed and the teams themselves must provide these. No powered tools or chain saws are allowed.

All tools and equipment used must be fit for purpose and be in good condition, well maintained and safely operated by members of the team at all times. Judges hold the power to stop the use of tool/piece of equipment if, in their view, it is not safe to use or is being handled/used in an unsafe manner.

All teams are required to dismantle their fence after the Presentation of Awards. Any team not complying with this ruling will be penalised.

Clearing the ground -Teams are required to clear away all debris and any off-cuts of wire etc. must not be put down the postholes. Receptacles will be provided for this purpose. Soil will be available to make the ground good.



List of Items provided by Brecknock YFC:

2 - 7' round posts, 5"-6" diameter (posts) 2 - 8' round posts, 3" - 4" diameter (struts) 3 - 5'6" round posts - 3"-4" diameter (stakes) Chogs - 4" x 2" flat rail Netting **Barbed Wire** Nails & Staples

#### TIMING

2 hours will be allowed to complete the task. Once the 2 hours is up teams will be asked to stop. If teams have not completed the fence they are then given the option to re-start and finish the fence off but there is to be penalties for every minute the team then goes over.

#### **Time Penalties**

Teams will be encouraged to complete the task but will lose one (1) point per minute over the allocated time.

If telephoning out of office hours then a message should be left on the answer phone.</u>

FOR COMPETITORS/TEAMS WHO DO NOT TURN UP FOR A COMPETITION ON THE DAY, THE COUNTY OFFICIALS WILL MAKE THE DECISION WHETHER TO DEDUCT THE 5 POINTS OR NOT, DEPENDING ON CIRCUMSTANCES.

<u>Please Note:</u> "That only members with up-to-date plastic membership cards and are on the database in the YFC Office are eligible to compete. Any new members forms and photos <u>must</u> be attached to the Entry Form when returned by clubs."

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> If a member does not produce an up-to-date membership card at the competition, it will result in a £5.00 fine. The fine will be refundable only if they provide confirmation of membership within 7 days of the Competition. If they have not yet joined, they will have 7 days to send a form and photograph to the YFC Office.
