TICKETS **MAXIMUM OF 6 TICKETS PER PERSON PER NIGHT**

Tickets will be sold from the Theatre Box Office from 10.00am, Tuesday 17th January. Bookings can be made in person or via the telephone, 01874 611622. <u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> TELEPHONE BOOKINGS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED UNTILL 12 Noon. Priority will be given to those people who book in person at the Box Office. <u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> The doors to the theatre will remain closed until county officials arrive when the doors open at 10.00AM people present will be issued with a ticket. A draw will be made to determine the order of ticket purchasing & there will then be one queue for the two box offices.

TICKET PRICES.

These will be £10.00 per ticket Tuesday-Friday (no concession for children); with a reduction if tickets are purchased for 3 nights or more at the same time, not including Gala Night to £9.00. Gala Evening tickets will be £13.00.

CAR PARKING

The Theatre have now introduced a Pay & Display Parking Charges, you must pay and display if parking in the Theatre Car Park. It is advisable that all stock boxes/lorries drop off set and then, park in the Council Car Park beyond the Job Centre. This Car Park is free after 6pm. Please do not park in the Job Centre Car Park or Aldi Car Park as you may get fined.

TICKET ALLOCATION

The allocation will be as below, with all tickets being reserved by the YFC Office (Please see instructions attached). Completed forms and money in full will be required in the YFC Office by 10 am Monday 16th January 2023 to book your allocation.

Please Note: If no notification is received by this time then no tickets will be reserved for the clubs.

INSPECTION OF STAGE AND TECHNICAL REHERSALS.

The Stage, Lighting and Sound Directors will be available in the Theatre on Friday 3rd February 5pm - 9.00pm, Saturday 4th and Sunday 5th February from 9am - 6pm for Producers to meet with them to discuss their requirements. The following times are allowed for each club:

Junior Drama 30 minutes
 Entertainment 60 minutes
 One Plus 10 minutes

If you wish to attend the technical rehearsals please let the YFC Office know by 4pm Thursday 12th January2023, which date is suitable for you. After this date a timetable will be drawn up and circulated.

If you are competing in more than one category and book the time in a bloc, the order of the rehearsals may change but the total time for each category must be adhered to.

On performance nights, clubs will not be allowed to practice on stage. Clubs will be allowed a sound check only with approximately 5 minutes for On Pluses and 10 minutes for Entertainments & Junior Dramas. Cast members and club helpers will have limited access to the stage on the performance nights; this will be monitored by the backstage stewards.

SCRIPTS AND CASTS

Full scripts to be submitted by the <u>4pm on the 12th January 2023</u>, as well as details of what you want in the programme. Any ammendments to the programme can be made at your technical rehersal.

PRS

If you are going to use any Disney Music you need to inform the YFC Office, as you will have to contact Warner Chappell for permission via www.warnerchappell.co.uk. Their address is 28 Kensington Church Street, London. W8 4EP. Tel: 02073 682500. You must have proof that you have the performance rights agreed by Disney, otherwise they will not be allowed to perform.

COPY RIGHT

Please ensure that you obtain <u>2 Performing Rights Licences</u> from the Author / Author's printing Company and forward them to the YFC Office in order that they can be passed on to the Adjudicator <u>before</u> the Festival begins. If you do not obtain permission and you are caught, you will have to stand the loss, which can be as much as £30,000!

MICROPHONES

There will be 14 clip on/head and 2 hand held that we can hire from the theatre.

Please note: Entertainments - a maximum of 6 head sets and 4 handheld microphones will be available.

FLYING

If clubs wish to have items flown from the bars then these items must be brought to the Technical rehearsal night. Clubs must provide their own wire and brackets to fasten all items they wish to be flown. Please note: Entertainments/Dramas can only have the use of three bars.

<u>Please Note</u> that this will not be the case should your production go forward to represent Brecknock in the Wales YFC Finals as there are NO flying facilities available. It was passed in the last Competitions meeting that if items to fly are not brought to the technical rehearsals then the item will not be flown on the night.

or

The theatre will provide a black or white back drop and you will be able to use any one of these. You can provide your own back drop but this will not be flown in and will be in place for the entire performance.

GOBOS

Please see the enclosed list of GOBOS available for use.

FIRE PROOFING

This will be very strict again this year. Please ensure that you fire proof thoroughly to avoid disappointment or even disaster! All props, sets, etc., will be tested with a flame for 15 seconds by theatre staff. If it isn't fire proofed, it will not be allowed to be used. No straw or hay will be allowed because of the fire hazard. If you wish to use these in your production, you need to make a box and stick the hay/straw to it and then fire proof.

STAGE MANAGER:

TECHNICAL REHEARSALS

Notes from the Theatre Skills night are attached, but please see below for a summary of points relevant to the Technical Rehearsals:

1. Lighting

- Follow spot the theatre have suggested that clubs need to supply their own operators.
- GOBO –Geraint has said its best that members come and see the GOBO's during the tech week.

2. Special Effects and Equipment

Please let the YFC Office know what equipment you required for your production, UV lights, Glitter Ball etc. as they will need to be hired, if you would like the equipment for the technical rehearsal please let us know as the equipment will need to be hired.

PLEASE NOTE: All equipment that needs to be hired will be charged to the club(s) that requests the equipment.

3. Pyro Flash

The Theatre can provide the equipment to fire two pyro's per club. Please let the office know by the 14th January if you would like to use Pryo's as requested by the theatre – if you do not let us know by this date you will NOT be able to use Pyro's during your performance.

4. Stage Manager

Each club needs to appoint a stage manager, who needs to be present at the Technical Rehearsal. They need to cue everything, a tip from the skills night is to work out lighting, sound and mic cues on a script and number each cue.

See notes from the Theatre Skills night overleaf for further details.

5. Recorded Music & Sound effects

All music needs to be on Mini Disc, or if you are unable to use a Mini Disc a CD is acceptable but needs to be good quality and recorded at a low speed. All discs need to be tracked.

NO TAPE will be accepted.

6. Live Music

Make sure that all musicians and their instruments are present at the Technical Rehearsals for a run through with the Sound Technicians.

7. Timing

Please make sure you arrive at the theatre ready to start your rehearsal at the allocated time. Your technical rehearsal will start at this time and not the time that you start.

PLEASE NOTE:

All music, lighting, special effect details etc. need to be at the Theatre for the Technical Rehearsals, if it is not it will NOT be used for the competition.
