<u>Mary Phillips Sports Trophy:</u> Points will be recorded as follows: For team or individual - 4 points for 1<sup>st</sup> place; 3 points for 2<sup>nd</sup>; 2 points for 3<sup>rd</sup> and 1 point for participation.

John Davies, Tyclyd, Beulah - Sports Trophy 18 years of age or under: Points will be recorded as follows: For team or individual - 4 points for 1<sup>st</sup> place; 3 points for 2<sup>nd</sup>; 2 points for 3<sup>rd</sup> and 1 point for participation.

- <u>PUNCTUALITY</u>- Please ensure that your competitors report on time for the competitions. No competition will be held up for late competitors.
- Competitors to report half an hour before the commencement of their respective competition for a Draw to be made.
- Play to commence promptly in each of the competitions.

Once a team signs in to play any sport and play begins, that original team must remain the same throughout the competiton. Guests must be a YFC member from another club within the Federation and not played/competed in the same competition on the day/evening. If clubs have one guest then points are given to the entered club. If clubs have more than one guest then the position points are split between <u>both</u> clubs.

Three or more clubs can form a team but will compete for fun, i.e. no points will be awarded. The Winning team, with or without guests, will go forward and represent the county.

### POOL - Boys Singles, Girls Singles & Mixed Doubles.

#### ELIGIBILITY

No restriction on number of entries allowed per club.

Members to be 17 Years of age and over on the 1<sup>st of</sup> September 2022.

#### PROCEDURE

Rules as per the British Association of Pool Table operators will apply.

Order of play determined by flip of a coin.

League type tables will be used whenever possible.

The facilities available will determine whether the competition will be played on a knockout or league basis and on the entries on the night.

- a. Knockout Best of three frames
- b. League One Straight frame

## DARTS- Boys Singles, Girls Singles & Mixed Doubles.



**ELIGIBILITY** No restriction on number of entries allowed per Club.

Members to be 17 years of age or over on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022.

## PROCEDURE

<u>Boys Singles:</u> Games to consist of 3 legs 501. Flying Start Double or Bull to finish. Throw for Bull in 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> legs

### Girls Singles:

Games to consist of 3 legs 301. Flying Start Double or Bull to finish. Throw for Bull in 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> legs.

Competitors to supply their own darts.

Points will be awarded for every leg won.

The dart board shall be standard 1-20 clock pattern, height 5'8" from centre of bull to floor level, and the minimum throwing distance shall be back edge of raised tow hockey 7'6" measured along the floor from face of board with also 8' line.

The "bust" rule will apply i.e., if you score more than you require you revert back to score required prior to your opponents' last throw.

The bull counts as 50. If 50 is required for game shot the bull does count as double 25.

No dart to be retrieved from the dart board until the score has been recorded by scorer/referee. Protest after retrieval of dart may not be accepted.

The score is counted from the side of segment wire the dart pierces.

The decision of the Referee will be final.

Draw to be made on the evening.

#### WITHDRAWAL FROM COMPETITIONS

Clubs/ Members are asked to notify the YFC Office of any withdrawals 5 days prior to a Competition. PLEASE NOTE: All withdrawals from Club secretaries/Members must be made by email or by telephoning the YFC Office. If telephoning out of office hours, then a message should be left on the YFC Mobile phone.

<u>Please Note:</u> That only members with up-to-date membership cards and are on the database in the YFC Office are eligible to compete. Members must apply online at least 5 Days before the competition.

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> If a member does not produce an up-to-date membership card at the competition, it will result in a £5.00 fine. The fine will be refundable only if they provide confirmation of membership within 7 days of the Competition.
